The Susquehanna River Basin Commission was contacted (around 2025) about the garbage and human waste from the homeless encampment behind Aldi. Not sure how to address clean up since there are various forms of hazardous waste including drug needles. Southside Dam has shopping carts in the water.

Discussion on placing a sign on the door of Town Hall with department phone numbers for people to call to be let inside later in the afternoons when there's only one or two employees in the building so the door can be locked.

Jeff has quotes for replacement of the grill on his vehicle.

Will is checking into grant options for new body camera for Constable.

Discussion on Code Office charging for Fire Inspections. The County Charges commercial properties based on sq footage, and residential by number of rooms. STR's already pay a fee that covers fire inspections. (Need to verify) Fees could help fund an additional code employee to help do these inspections.

Nicole will submit quote for highway garage security cameras and we will put that under Highway on our meeting agenda.
