Highway, Water & Sewer Committee Meeting Notes 7 April 2026

Those in attendance: Cody Schmitt, Highway Superintendent, Trish Riddell Kent, Chair, Joe Camarata, Teresa DeSantis and Nicole Camarata

Cody is working on placing Speed Monitoring Sign from Winney Hill Rd on Richard's Ave. It needed some repair work. Trish also has Speed Trailer request in with the Sheriff's office that should be in place soon.

East Street Culvert-Cody met with Alex Herman to assist with engineering for this high priority culvert project. Cody has already met with the DEC. Alex said the next step is to hire surveyors since there are elevation aspects of the project.

Cody has worked extremely hard pricing aggregates and delivery cost in preparation of his 284 Agreement for the Town Board for the expenditure of highway monies on road work for the coming year.

Road sweeping in rural areas has already begun. The rental sweeper with vac (J&J Equipment) for the more densely

populated neighborhoods with storm drains won't be available until mid-May.

Spring Brush and Leaf Pickup Mondays April 13-May 11

Cody and Dale Webster met with Gary Eichler from the DOT in mid-March. Gary works closely with Eric Burton an engineer with the DOT. They met at sidewalk from Reinhardt to Forest Ave. Gary emailed DOT specs for that section of sidewalk along Route 23. Cody is reaching out to contractors who have kindly submitted bids last fall with these new specs so they can submit new bids. If there's enough money in the budget, we can look at section of sidewalk along County Route 8 to the West Oneonta Cemetery. Patching the area of sidewalk on Bulter St until entire sidewalk can be fully done was also discussed.

We also discussed the Old Town Hall building. Dale wondered if junk could be removed from the Town's area of the building, and utilize the space for Town Historical location. Dale volunteered to work on chimney repair. Nicole thought this would be an ideal project to type up a short proposal and submit to MVEDD for their assistance.

CSC Task Force will look into possible grant funding for solar and battery backup for the Southside Water Tank.

Jay's Place reached out to Highway Dept about delivery truck access to his restaurant from Van Woert Street.

Enck Water Connection work to his property at County Route 47 & 58 has begun.
