

Highway, Water and Sewer Committee Minutes May 5, 2026

Mr and Mrs Silvernail from Township Rd attended to discuss the challenges of driving their large RV out the driveway on this dead-end road. It's difficult to make a wide swing out of the driveway when residents park vehicles on the street. No Parking signage was requested.

Jarrett submitted 3 bids for a Chlorine Analyzer along with programming costs. AquaLogics was lowest amount and best value \$10,229. Jarrett said AquaLogics products, service and response are also the best out there.

Jarrett sent Well Control building and pump station generator quotes spreadsheet to the Town Board for consideration at the May meeting. He prioritized their ranking in order of greatest need. Panel upgrades are needed at West St and Southside pump stations.

Approval of water rates for Woodland Water District and Southside Water District for agenda.

Sweeper vac rental is here and being used to do neighborhoods and clean storm drains. Rental was through J & J Equipment Brewerton, NY.

The new highway truck will finally be delivered next month. This is a pre-approved, budgeted purchase and was ordered a few years ago. Discussion on allocating 75% of the purchase cost to the water districts and 25% to the highway fund. We will get legal guidance from our Town Attorney on how to appropriately handle. Going forward will need to keep track of how much time the truck is actually used for water & sewer district work, and how much time for work outside of those districts like plowing snow on the remaining Town roads. We can re-examine in one year and make adjustments.

West Oneonta sidewalks-We have only received one bid to date. The challenge for contractors is need to hire flaggers to control one lane traffic. Cody will discuss with DOT to see if they can provide flagger assistance.

Stop sign needed for Lutz Feed intersection. Cody will reach out to the County Highway Dept. with request.
